Police have been told Lola was wrapped in a blanket, carried to a car and driven away by her former boyfriend for a party which included 4 gay guys and 2 straight guys. 1 of the gay guys has since deceased. 1 of the gay guys is HIV positive today. The ex-boyfriend’s account was that Lola was at his home and he left her there and went to work. When he returned an hour later he says Lola and her car were gone. State police records show he failed two polygraph tests.

Circumstances: Danielle's photo is shown age-progressed to 17 years. She may be in the Camden or Trenton area of New Jersey. She has pierced ears and a scar under one of her shoulder blades. When Danielle was last seen, she had braces on her teeth. Danielle may be in need of medical attention. She may use the alias last name Spivey. Her nickname is Dani.
